- ❖ Internship: emergency- pre hospital emergency- headquarters of accidents and disasters
- ❖ Number of standby: 33 standbys: 9 night works, 12 morning works, 12 evening works
- ❖ Educational workshop: clinical governance workshop

Fourth semester: 10 credits (3 credits thesis+ 6 credits internship)

- ❖ Courses: continuation of thesis and defending session
    - Internship: 6 credits (code 16)
    - Internship for 3 months in field full time, shift in circulation
    - Place in all parts of surgeries and internal, emergencies
    - Each month 136 hours, totally 408 hours (standbys: 16 night works, 20 morning works, 16 evening works)
