Note 1: In order to implement the Nursing Curriculum approved by the Supreme Council of Medical Sciences Planning and to achieve community-based nursing goals, all areas of training and apprenticeships have a special focus on the client, the family and the community. Assessment of client and family health status at admission, following up of client and family status during hospitalization and discharging and following up of client status at home, factory visit, school and any other community to which the client belongs, is mandatory.

Note 2: All students are required to complete the log book as they complete their internships and internships.

Note 3: Upon completion of field training, it is necessary to successfully complete the final practical exam. If a student fails the test, he or she will be re-trained in the field, and then participate in the re-test.

## Course description

During the 4 years (8 semesters), students complete basic, specialized and internship courses in the form of theoretical, practical and internship courses, and in the 4<sup>th</sup> year they complete their internship in the field in the form of shift in work. The following tables are required for an internship in the seventh and eighth semesters.

### Half seventh year: credit sum: 11 credits of internship in the field

11 credits (56 hours)

\*Places of internship in the field: related units with Adult /elderly (1,2,3) and Critical Care units.

\*Number of shifts: 84 shifts: 10-night works in each month 1 or 2 nights (120 hours), 64 morning works (384 hours) – 10 evening works (60 hours)

# Half eighth year: credit sum: 10 credits of internship in the field

10 credits (510 hours)

\*Places of internship in the field: Urban and rural health centers and home visits- Obstetrics, Gynecology, Neonatal, Pediatrics, Internal and Surgery wards, Emergency wards

\*Number of shifts: 75 shifts: 10-night works (120 hours)- 60 morning works (360 hours)- 5 evening works (30 hours)

Notes: Students are required to complete specialized skills approved by the logbook.
